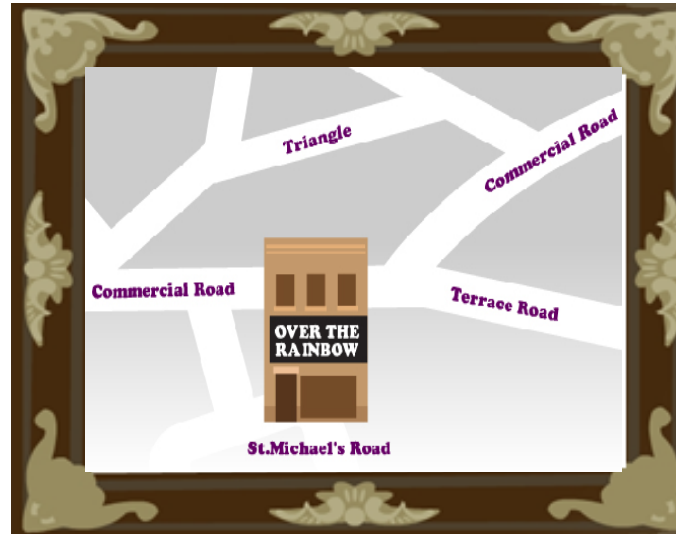

- Syphilis

- HEP B
- HEP C
